Stop 5 The last stop of the tour will be at the original farmhouse of Monday night's keynote speaker and South Australia culinary icon Maggie Beer. Here, delegates will be able to sample and purchase a wide range of gourmet morsels. Finally the bus will take delegates back to Prince Alfred College in time for the conference registration evening to taste more of Australia.
